MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Lewandowski called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. on January 14, 2020 at the Palos Heights City Hall, 7607 W. College Drive. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PERMANENT SIGN REQUEST – REVIVAL CYCLE

He stated that Revival desired a larger sign with a light box. Committee members reviewed the request and asked questions to clarify size and type of lighting. The proposed size is within code. Alderman Kramarski remarked that it would be an improvement to that shopping center.
