a. Budget Proposal-

- b. 76<sup>th</sup> Ave Sculpture– The landscape plan shown to us does not reflect the actual implementation of the plan. Currently there is too much snow on the ground to see the site, we will revisit the in the spring to determine if this is still an appropriate site for a sculpture installation.
- c. Treasures of Palos Anchor Tiles – The tiles are completed and our beautiful. Anne Farley-Gaines will return sometime in April, under the supervision of Public works to install the new tiles. Anne will also submit a sketch for a design of a canopy to be fabricated or purchased to install over mural for additional protection of the mural. Lynda will talk to Noral Jewelers, regarding the integrity and maintenance of the wall the mural is mounted on.
- d. Approval of Bill – Motion to pay Anne Farley-Gaines \$1,000 for the fabrication of three new replacement anchor tiles; Lake Katherine, Palos Health, and Palos Chamber of Commerce, by Maria DeCaprio- Sunta, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kathy Peters, motion approved by all. Maria will present the bill to Public Works for payment.

### IV. New Business

a. 2021 Initiatives – Holiday Light Display; Maria spoke with Scott from Illunight Lighting regarding the possibility of a interactive/outdoor walk through light display, with music. Cost would be approximately 15,000. Some discussion and thoughts where were to look for collaboration with the city or other groups interested in pursuing an event such as this, perhaps in coordination with the Kris Kringle Market. Further discussion will take place upon receipt of a proposal from Illuminight Lighting.

- b. Pop-Up Store – Discussion to pursue a Pop-Up holiday store on Harlem. Some of the possibilities discussed were to utilize one of the empty storefronts, collaborating with the city for permitting and insurance, coordination of artists who are selling to help with manpower during operational hours.

V. **Misellaneous**

- a. Lynda suggested pursuing some type of sculpture piece for the planting bed in front of city hall. Discussion of something really simple described as 3 - 2 dimensional stakes fabricated from metal with inserted colored glass shapes. Vanessa will reach out to students at MIAD to seek interest in fabrication of these pieces.
