College Drive, Palos Heights, Illinois will be open during regular business hours from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. beginning Tuesday, December 22, 2020 through Wednesday, December 23, 2020 and Monday, December 28, 2020 through Wednesday, December 30, 2020 for the purpose of accepting objections to nominating papers for the Consolidated Election to be held on April 6, 2021. Please note City offices are closed December 25, 2020.

Any objections to nominating petitions must be filed with the office of the City Clerk (who received the original petitions) within five business days following the last day of the petition filing period, as provided above.
