



Dear Resident,

The City of Palos Heights is scheduled to commence the 123rd Street Reconstruction Project along 123rd Street between 76th Ave and Harlem Ave on June 14, 2021. The City received federal grants for the improvement of the 123rd Street which will include storm sewer improvements, roadway ditch regrading, watermain installation, full roadway reconstruction, and a new public sidewalk from Harlem Avenue to Palmer Park. Lindahl Brothers Inc. will be the general contractor responsible for the successful completion of the project.

During construction, you may be inconvenienced by the presence of construction vehicles, road closures, underground utility excavation, dust, noise, and other construction related activities. Please note the City's Right of Way (City Property) on 123rd Street extends up to 45 feet from the centerline of the road in some areas; therefore, some construction activities may extend deeper into the parkway. The contractors are made aware not to trespass on private property, stay within the City's Right of Way, and notify residents at least a day in advance if driveways will be blocked. Any permitted site landscaping, damaged by construction activity, will be restored to preconstruction condition if possible.

Nicor Gas is currently working on 123rd Street with their utility relocation project. They are scheduled for completion during the second week of June. Once they complete their portion of the project, the City's contractor will commence with watermain installation followed by storm sewer reconstruction. Upon completion of the underground work, full roadway reconstruction will begin including driveway culvert replacement and sidewalk construction. We anticipate the work being completed by November 2021.
